

Important Note from Marcus Bell on Thesis Documents

We are in the process of updating these documents to minimize redundancies and confusion. For now, please bear in mind the following caveats: Do NOT use any links that appear within the documents themselves, as they may point to older items. For that matter, the standalone checklist is newer than the one embedded in the Thesis Requirements; use the newer one, of course. Some of the pages are counted in the thesis numbering scheme but the number is not printed on the page itself. So where the checklist says "pages must be numbered", finish the sentence with "as described in the Thesis Requirements". The abbreviated checklist is not a substitute for the larger document. The Thesis Requirements refer to the "Senior Associate Dean for Curriculum and Research". For the purposes of your thesis, that role is handled by the "Program Director, Research, Master of Science in Biomedical Sciences", which is myself.
